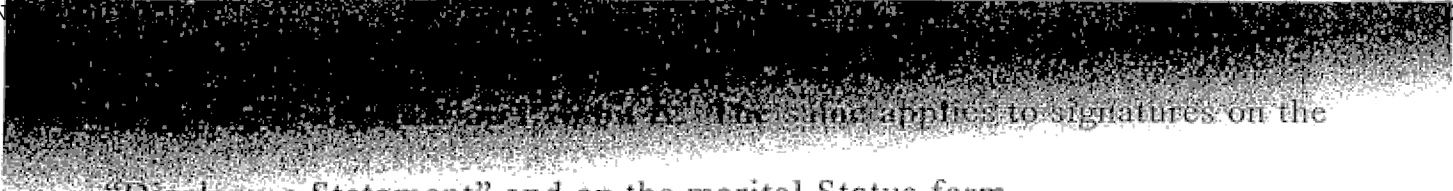

3. I have reviewed the papers appended to the Amended Order entered on 12/08/2016. Only one signature attributed to me is mine and that is on Exhibit A, Certificate of Term Payment
4. Exhibit D is allegedly the Lottery Prize Assignment Agreement. The signature on page 6 of that document is not mine, as is clear from mere



The same applies to signatures on the "Disclosure Statement" and on the marital Status form.

5, The "Affidavit" is also forged, see page 3 and I never signed anything relating to these winnings other than Exhibit A before a notary Public.

6. Robert G. Schacht claims to be my attorney. I do not know him. His office is on Staten Island. I live and work in the Bronx and have never been to Staten Island.

7 I did not sell a portion of my winnings to this petitioner. I did borrow \$220,000 from them. I was told to repay that loan at 40 Wall Street.


