In the Matter of Transferred Structured Settlement Payments

After an audit of court records and analysis of your past transaction, it has come to our attention that you may not have received the full value to which you were entitled. New laws that were implemented, pursuant to the Victims of Terrorism Relief Act of 2001, IRS Code § 5891, et seq., now allow structured settlement recipients to re-process their past transactions through the court, taking advantage of a judge's approval. Based on stochastic analytics, it is our opinion that all transferees of structured settlement payments should evaluate their past transactions for any potential financial anomalies.

By not responding by or before April 15th, 2007, you shall forfeit your right to have your file reviewed; therefore, you are urged to contact our processing partner as soon as possible at 800-981-5969 to determine the results of the aforementioned analysis and how this can affect you.
